

Super-Secret Dish Cloth Pattern

I found a cone of Sugar and Cream at the Goodwill store, and when I opened the bag, I found this handwritten pattern in the bottom of the cone! What a surprise! I decoded the script and typed it up so that I could easily read it and carry it around without ruining the original pattern. That I am keeping in my pattern binder.

Materials:

Size 6 or 7 straight needles (I used sized 7, and filled up the whole needle with the stitches)

1 ball Sugar 'n Cream or other worsted weight yarn. I'm not sure of the yardage, as I'm using partial cones and balls from my stash.

Cast on 5 sts.

Row 1: Knit across

Row 2: Knit across

Row 3: K2, yo, k across to end

Row 4-Repeat row 3 until there are 52 stitches on the needle

Decrease as follows: K1, K2tog, yo, k2tog knit to end

Continue decreasing until there are 5 sts on the needle, Cast off.
